For employers, apprenticeships are an effective way to bridge the skills gap within their current workforce and help managers with their personal development.


For learners, degree apprenticeships provide the ability to study without putting their career on hold, and as it's predominantly online, with just one face- to-face session a quarter.

Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship BA (Hons) Business Management (CMI)

The Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship (CMI) is aimed at first time or aspiring managers, or alternatively existing managers who have workplace management experience but who have limited formal training and are looking to build management skills and achieve a degree.

It will equip students with the knowledge and understanding of key and cross-functional business and management disciplines while they continue to work in their current role. They'll study for a degree alongside work-based learning, where they can apply their knowledge directly to their role. Whether it's developing personal and management skills or the ability to understand people within organisations, this chartered management course means they'll graduate with an accredited degree and work-based learning experience.

Chartered Management Institute (CMI) accreditationUpon completion of this degree apprenticeship, learners

will achieve a Level 5 Diploma in Management & Leadership and are able to apply for Chartered Manager status.

CMI promotes excellence in UK management and leadership, and learners will have free CMI membership throughout their studies. This includes access to a range of resources including a large online library, the CMI mentoring service and UK networking events.

Courses entry requirements:

For learners to enrol on this degree apprenticeship they must:

- ► Be in employment and have written evidence confirming support from their employer.
- ► Have evidence of funding eligibility from their employer.
- ► Two subjects at GCE A-level or equivalent.
- ► Passes at grade C or above in Maths and English, plus one other subject, at GCSE level or equivalent;
- Or, have completed a recognised Access Programme or equivalent.

For students whose prior learning was not taught in English:

▶ IELTS 6.0 or equivalent (no less than 5.5 in any element).

If you don't have English and/or Maths qualifications (level 2): You will need to commit to achieving these qualifications by the end of your apprenticeship. This will be facilitated at no additional cost to the learner.

Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship BA (Hons) Business Management (CMI) with level 5 exemptions

For managers who have already completed their level 5 apprenticeship, we may be able to create a bespoke, shorter package on a case-by-case basis, for students that want to develop to level 6 and achieve their degree.

Courses entry requirements:

For learners to enrol on this degree apprenticeship they must:

- ► Hold a Level 5 Operations Departmental Manager certificate with either CMI or ILM Level 5 Diploma
- ▶ Be in employment and have written evidence confirming support from their employer.
- ► Have evidence of funding eligibility from their employer.
- ► Two subjects at GCE A-level or equivalent.
- ► Passes at grade C or above in Maths and English, plus one other subject, at GCSE level or equivalent;
- Or, have completed a recognised Access Programme or equivalent.

For students whose prior learning was not taught in English:

► IELTS 6.0 or equivalent (no less than 5.5 in any element).

If you don't have English and/or Maths qualifications (level 2): You will need to commit to achieving these qualifications by the end of your apprenticeship. This will be facilitated at no additional cost to the learner.

The Senior Leader Apprenticeship plus MBA (CMI)

The Senior Leader Apprenticeship plus MBA provides apprentices with the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to implement positive change to their organisations from the get-go.

Aimed at senior leaders, with significant experience, looking to further build their leadership capability and achieve an MBA, this is designed to accelerate students as they expand and formalise their management experience.

Covering modules such as implementing business strategies and ethical leadership, this senior leader apprenticeship will refine and sharpen existing skills, giving students everything they need to succeed in the modern workplace.

As well as awarding a Level 7 Senior Leader Apprenticeship, students at Arden will also receive a Master of Business Administration at no additional cost. Students will attend live sessions with academics and have an assigned professional coach who will visit and assess them within the workplace.

Educating senior managers or executives can not only help maximise the success of UK organisations, but investing in employees is essential for organisations preparing for challenges ahead. Businesses who develop current staff with change management skills can help enhance productivity and planning and can also help bridge vulnerabilities within the workforce.

Future disruptions mean that managers and leaders need to be agile, resilient, able to be capable digital leaders, in order to ensure business stability and continuity. By readying these future leaders with the business skills they require it benefits both the employer and the employee.

Courses entry requirements:

For learners to enrol on this apprenticeship they must:

- ▶ Be in employment and have written evidence confirming support from their employer.
- ► Have evidence of funding eligibility from their employer.
- ► Have achieved a UK Honours Degree at a minimum of second class (2.2) or equivalent, plus a minimum of two years' work experience.
- ▶ Passes at grade C or above in English and Maths GCSE level or equivalent; For students who do not have academic qualifications, we also consider your application based on 5 years' management experience.

For students whose prior learning was not taught in English:

▶ IELTS 6.5 or equivalent (no less than 6.0 in any element).

If you don't have English and/or Maths qualifications (level 2): You will need to commit to achieving these qualifications by the end of your apprenticeship. This will be facilitated at no additional cost to the learner.
